Why Rose for the 3rd Sunday of Advent

The 3rd Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday. The word, Gaudete, is derived from the Latin word, Gaudium (joy) and gaudeo (rejoice or be glad). On the 3rd Sunday of Advent, the church uses rose paraments and vestments. We have multiple reasons for being joyful. There is joy in looking forward to the annual celebration of Christmas. There is joy in recalling the birth of Jesus on that first Christmas. There is joy in the reason for Jesus' birth, that he was born to save us from our sins. Lastly, there is joy in the anticipation of Jesus' Second Coming, either at the end of our physical life or the end of the world.

Christmas can be a painful time for some. It may be the first Christmas without a loved family member who has recently died; it may be a time that has always been difficult. The constant refrain on the radio and television, in shopping malls and churches, about the happiness of the season, about getting together with family and friends, reminds many people of what they have lost or have never had. The anguish of broken relationships, the insecurity of unemployment, the weariness of ill health, the pain of isolation - all these can make us feel very alone in the midst of the celebrating and spending. We need the space and time to acknowledge our sadness and concern; we need to know that we are not alone. Our spirits sink, as the days grow shorter. We feel the darkness growing deeper around us. We need encouragement to live the days ahead of us. For these reasons, St. David's will offer a special "Longest Night" service on **Sunday, December 21st at 6:30PM.** Come out, and join with us in sharing and hearing prayers, scripture, and music that acknowledge that God's presence is for those who mourn, for those who struggle - and that God's Word comes to shine light into our darkness. Everyone, regardless of church background (or lack of it) is welcome. The service will be followed by a brief time for light refreshments and fellowship.
