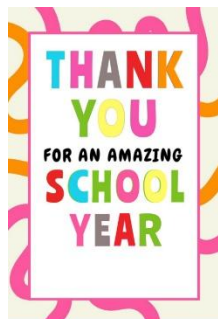


We only have a few spots open for Preschool 4 for the 2026-2027 school year.
