#### **Lutheran World Relief**

Last Sunday, the final ingathering for Lutheran World Relief (LWR), we received \$385. When added to the \$2,115 amount previously received, the ingathering of monetary gifts totaled \$2,500, which is 25% over our original goal! In addition, 19 blankets, made by the "knotty ladies" and GWOH "knotters", are being sent to LWR as well. **Great job, people of St. David's!** The \$385 received last Sunday will be designated for blankets (\$5 per blanket means that \$385 will buy 77 blankets -- fantastic!). LWR will use the remaining \$2,115 for personal care kits, school kits, education opportunities, for seeds and animals sharing them with families in poor communities across the globe to assist them in becoming self-sufficient. The recipients of these gifts, we are touching with our offerings, will be helped in times of crisis and as they learn to become self-sustaining. Imagine how thankful those individuals and families will be. Because of our monetary and blanket gifts people somewhere in our world, in the not too distant future will be saying to an LWR worker ... THANK YOU! Blessed by God, we, in turn, are empowered to be a blessing to others!
