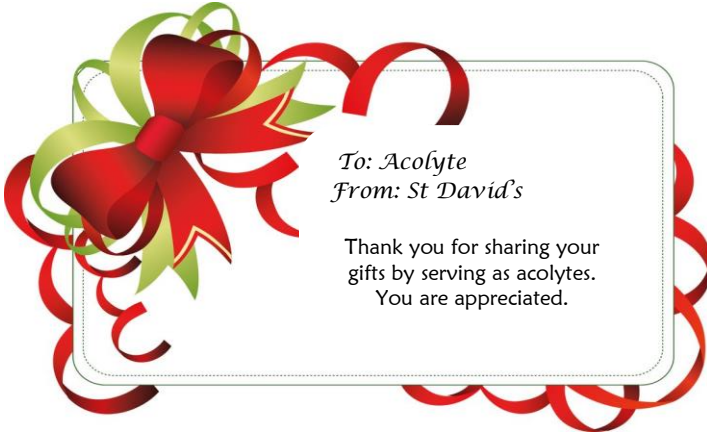
Members & Guests joining us for worship are reminded to fill out the attendance sheet in the pew pads located at the beginning of each pew.
