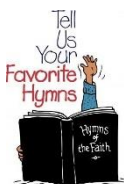

God's Work, Our Hands (GWOH) Project

The war in Ukraine has “drained” the number of Personal Care Kits that Lutheran World Relief and Church World Service have ... so one of our two 2022 GWOH projects will be to collect and pack 150 Personal Care Kits.

The first step in this project is to collect the items needed for the kits. Look for the Personal Care Kit Board in the narthex of the church as you enter for worship. Please take the number of tags for each item on the board you intend to buy (that is how we keep track of how many items we can count on being donated). After purchasing those items, please bring them to the church and place them in the Collection Box ... also in the narthex.

Step two packing those kits will occur on GWOH Sunday, September 11.

The items needed are listed below.

Items Needed for Personal Care Kits

- **One light-weight, dark colored bath-size towel**
- **Two bath-sized bars of soap in original wrapping**
- **One adult toothbrush in original packaging**
- **One sturdy comb**
- **One metal nail clippers**
