In trying to reach everyone, we are reaching out in different ways. If you are already volunteering, there is no need to do anything more. But if you aren't or would like to try something different, please do!

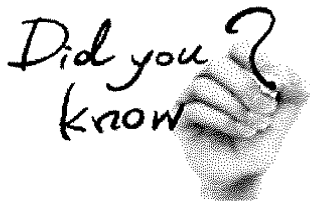

Hosting consists of a family or family groups being the worship volunteers together in as many roles as they would like. This could be acolytes, communion assistants, lector's, ushers or even cantors. If there is a role that the group is unable or uncomfortable doing, we will fill those spaces as we usually do.
