Update from St. David's Learning Place,

With everything going on with COVID-19 the staff at St. David's Learning Place are doing our best to keep everyone safe and healthy! Staff is required to wear a mask when inside the building, students and staff are being temperature checked before coming in the building. During this time, parents are not permitted into the building. We have been listening to the Governor as well as The Office Early Learning and Child Development for their recommendations as we have been moving forward.

Moving forward we are asking the church to also following the follow guidelines if you must come downstairs when the students are present (Monday-Friday 6:45a-5:45p):

- You **MUST** wear a mask at all times.
- You need to find Bekah Adams (the Director) to have your temperature checked.
- If you have a fever of 100 degrees or higher you could be asked to leave.
- Wash your hands before entering and leaving the school.
- If you move anything you need to make a staff member aware so that we can clean the surface.
- If you clean the surface yourself, you must use a disinfectant to ensure that the surface is clean.

All of these guidelines are in effect for all inside areas that St. David's Learning Place students could enter. This is including but not limited to all classrooms, fellowship hall, and kitchen. This is to ensure the safety of all students, staff and congregation members. As always thank you for your continued support of our program!
