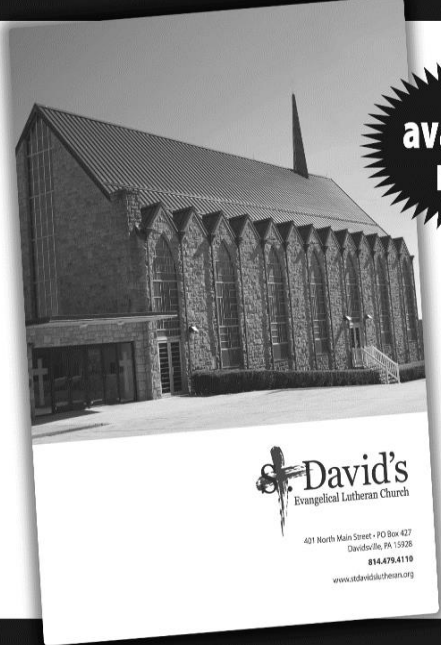
**Laurel View’s Basket Bash
