What is TITHING?

It is making a voluntary, systematic contribution of financial support to your church. Voluntary is defined as...giving out of love and gratitude for all God gives you. Systematic is defined as...giving a predetermined portion of your income as you receive it.

The Old Testament Guideline for giving was a “tithe” or a tenth of total property. Yes, there are people today who tithe their income. Other persons who are working toward a tithe or who give beyond the tithe, speak of proportionate or percentage giving.

Today the tithing tradition remains an important part of church life for many Christians. How important is it to you?

Jacob vowed, “If God will be with me, ... and will give me bread to eat and clothing to wear, ... then the Lord shall be my God, and this stone ... shall be God’s house; and of all that you give me I will surely give one tenth to you.” [Genesis 28:20-22 NRSV]

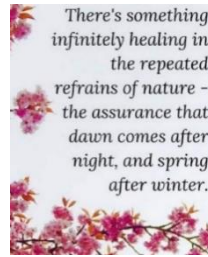

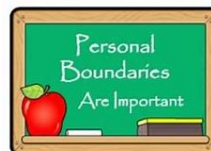
