From Pastor Mark:





Meet Stumpy the Japanese cherry tree. This tree is one of hundreds of Japanese Cherry trees that line the Potomac River in Washington, D.C. Nothing special to look at. Stumpy is the hunchback of cherry trees. To be honest, I don't know that I would want that tree in my back yard. You wonder how this tree manages to even bloom given its short stature and lack of

limbs. It is a tree of indeterminate age, thought to be around 25 years old. Yet year after year, Stumpy continues to defy the odds and bloom & blossom. It has survived at least six presidential election cycles, earthquakes (2011), blizzards (January 2016), hurricanes (Hurricane Isabel, 2003), record low's (2009, 8 above) and high's (summer of 2011 & 2012 with several days well above 100 degrees). Stumpy has survived <u>AND</u> thrived when other Japanese cherry trees in the Washington, D.C. area have not fared well at all. **WHY?**

Which begats the question: Why do some churches thrive and other churches do not? I can think of three reasons why churches thrive: 1) Creativity & Innovation, 2) Hospitality, and 3) Generosity.

- 1) Creativity & Innovation >>>> Churches that do not innovate and change do not grow. Especially since COVID-19 and the ensuing pandemic, congregations needed to be creative and innovative if they wanted to remain healthy. I believe St. David's does a good job of being creative and innovative. Instead of utilizing the counselors at Camp Sequanota, our VBS program was led by our Jr./Sr. High youth and we had over 40 young children who attended all or some of the days. St. David's took a leap of faith with the Jr./Sr. youth and WOW it worked. If a church is not willing to risk and take that leap of faith, one will never know what fruit can come from it.
- **2) Hospitality**>>>>>Churches that are opening, welcoming, and extend hospitality thrive and grow. If you talk to people who lead seminars on church growth and innovation, like Mark Tidsworth and Dave Daubert, a common theme for growing churches is that they are open, welcoming, and extend hospitality. This year, 2024, we have welcomed five new families into our fellowship and I received a message from another person that they are interested in joining our fellowship here at St. David's. If you ask any of these families, I am willing to bet that of the things they like about St. David's is that they feel welcome here and that their gifts and talents are appreciated. Another example of hospitality is the Overtime Ministry. On the Fridays that we hosted the Overtime Ministry last fall, I don't have enough fingers and thumbs to count the number of times, I heard the students thank me for having this program. We have opened our doors and made these young people feel welcome.

3) Generosity>>>>Generous churches are thriving churches!!!!! If you are free on a Wednesday night that the Stewardship and Finance Ministry Team meets, you will hear the conversation center on how St. David's blessed with its financial gifts and how we, St. David's, can share the abundance over and above seeing that the bills of the congregation are paid. Did you know that St. David's tithes to the Allegheny Synod 10% of its monthly offering. That tithe does more than pay the salaries of the Allegheny Synod staff; it goes to help students of the Allegheny Synod enrolled in seminaries throughout the ELCA, it goes to help support the ministry of Camp Sequanota, and it goes to further the work of the ELCA churchwide organization like helping to plan a national youth gathering.

An author wrote, "Complacency becomes rot." This is so true. As well as our VBS program ran, and it ran very well, it was necessary to sit down and review the week to see how we can make it better. That is what the VBS Ministry Team did the week after; sit down with all those involved in a leadership role and brainstorm what went right, what could be improved, and begin to plan for VBS 2025. In the St. David's congregation constitution, church council members can only serve one full three-year term and then go off church council for a year if they want to serve another term. That is smart; many churches allow members to serve two three-year terms consecutively, go off for a year, and then come back to church council and serve another two three year terms. Same for committees/ministry teams. Where there is no "new blood", creativity and innovation slow to a crawl and can eventually not happen.

I am writing this reflection in the days after our Sunday conversation on the third petition of The Lord's Prayer: *Thy will be done on earth as in heaven*. We, as disciples, are called to be active and willing participants in seeing that God's will is done here on earth. This is the work to which we have been called in our baptisms: to actively participate in the work of the Church so that God's will is done here on earth. If you have thought about participating on a ministry team, volunteering at St. Francis Caring & Sharing, serving on St. David's church council, or any other cause that seeks to do God's will, stand up, raise your hand, whatever. If we don't do the work of the Church, God will find others to do it.
