#### Pastor Mark's Reflection for January, 2025

Dear Friends in Christ,

While New Year's Day marks the world's end to Christmas, we get an extra Sunday of Christmas. We get an extra Sunday of baby Jesus. By New Years Day, the reality is that many of us have or soon will have taken down our Christmas decorations; the tree if we had a fresh-cut tree will be at the curb ready for pick-up, our children will be back in school and we will be back busy at our vocations. We put Jesus the baby away for another year. Rarely do any of us treat the Season of Christmas s a twelve day season except in the song, *The Twelve Days of Christmas*.

This is our challenge. Jesus hasn't left; he hasn't gone anywhere. We enter the Epiphany Season on Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup> when we celebrate the magi visitation to the infant Jesus in Bethlehem. Boom! Sunday, January 12<sup>th</sup> we now have an adult Jesus being baptized in the Jordan River by John the Baptizer. The kicker is we need a day of epiphany, a day of revealing Christ the Savior to the world. {The shame of all this is that we, St. David's Lutheran Church like many Protestant churches do not celebrate the Epiphany of Jesus unless January 6<sup>th</sup> falls on a Sunday; almost like starting Lent without Ash Wednesday.}

The day of Epiphany is important! The ancient church highlighted three manifestations or epiphanies of God in the person of Jesus Christ. The first of these epiphanies is The Day of Epiphany when we celebrate Jesus' revelation to the non-Jewish world as represented by the visit of the three wise men or magi. If we read the lessons for Epiphany, we hear "The splendor of the LORD shines on you! His splendor appears over you." from the 60th chapter of Isaiah, and through Paul's letter to the Ephesians, one hears that the people of Ephesus have "a divine revelation of the divine secret." from Paul to the people of Ephesus and "Gentiles are fellow heirs, fellow members of the body {of Christ}." The second of these epiphanies will take place on the following Sunday, January 12th, when we celebrate Jesus' baptism by John in the Jordan River and we hear God's voice from heaven saying, "You are my beloved Son; in you I take great delight." The third manifestation or epiphany is the wedding feast in Cana (John 2:1-11) where the gospel writer writes, "Jesus did this as the first of his miraculous signs, in Cana of Galilee. In this way, Jesus revealed his glory, and his disciples believed in him."

If our challenge is to live into the true meaning of the Season of Epiphany, then perhaps we should take seriously the message of the Day of Epiphany, that without the revelation of Jesus Christ to those who came before us to today, and to those who will come after, we would be living an empty life without the knowledge of the gift of eternal life. To meet this challenge, our Minister of Music, Brett has created a service of *Epiphany Lessons and Carols*. We will walk with the magi as they bring their gifts to the holy family, We will join with Jesus in the waters of the Jordan River and lastly we will celebrate the final manifestation as Jesus turns water into wine.

Please join us for this special time of music and lessons.
