- Tom Mitchell gave a report on VBS. They are looking at utilizing our youth from within our congregation to help with the week. Will get back to us with a definite date and ask for volunteers to help support this program and outreach which is always a great success

Pastors Report

- Thanked us for the time off for his knee surgery.
- Sending the \$500 donated for Lindsie Hammaker to ULS which will be credited to her account
- Would like to have the staff job descriptions revisited and made more consistent. Committee was formed to start moving forward with this.
- Working with Brett about worship ideas for Holy Week, Easter, and Sundays after Easter
- Trying to keep 8:00 AM worship ending times as close to 9 AM as possible so as not to interfere with any programs immediately following.

- Is involved with SAM (Somerset Area Ministerial). Last meeting was on issues facing residents of Somerset County. Has volunteered to lead the March 13th Mid-Week Lenten worship at 1st Methodist Church, Somerset. This starts at 11:30 AM with music and worship service at Noon. Meal to follow.
